INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for the following work in the Town of Wilmington, Massachusetts, will be received at the Office of the Town Manager, Town Hall, 121 Glen Road, Wilmington, Massachusetts 01887, until **10:00 a.m. on May 10, 2017**, where and when they will be publicly opened and read aloud:

**Route 125
(Ballardvale Street)
Water Main
Replacement**

Work involves the installation of approximately 3,800 linear feet of a 12-inch diameter ductile iron water main; abandonment of existing water main in place; and completing connections from existing mains, branches and services to the new ductile iron water main.

Contract documents may be obtained in hard copy at the Town Manager's Office, 121 Glen Road, Wilmington, MA, electronically by emailing wmartiniello@wilmingtonma.gov or online at www.wilmingtonma.gov.

There will be a non-refundable mailing fee of \$100.00 which must be made in the form of a certified, treasurer's, or cashier's check payable to the Town for each set of documents requested to be mailed. Documents will be mailed upon receipt of the non-refundable mailing fee.

File original bid at the Town Manager's Office, Town Hall, 121 Glen Road, Wilmington, Massachusetts 01887. Mark each envelope: **"Route 125 (Ballardvale Street) Water Main Replacement to be opened at 10:00 a.m. on May 10, 2017."**

Any bid may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time. Any bid received after the time and date specified will be rejected.

All bids for this project are subject to applicable bidding laws of Massachusetts, including General Laws Chapter 30, Section 39M as amended. All bids shall be accompanied by a bid deposit in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the bid amount. A Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials Payment Bond will be required of the successful bidder.

Bidders are hereby notified that the work covered by this contract is governed by M.G.L. c149 Section 26-27H and in accordance therewith bidders must pay prevailing wages as established by the Massachusetts Department of Labor and Workforce Development/ Division of Occupational Safety.

Purchases by the Town of Wilmington are exempt from any Federal, State, Municipal and/or excise tax.

The Town of Wilmington reserves the right to waive any formality and/or to reject any or all bids or any parts thereof deemed not to be in the best interest of the Town of Wilmington.

Bid award will only be valid pending approval of available funding.

The bidder certifies under penalties of perjury that this bid has been made and submitted in good faith and without collusion or fraud with any other person. As used in this certification, the word "person" shall mean any natural person, business, partnership, corporation, union, committee, club or other organization, entity, or group of individuals.
