

Janet Coulouris Memorial Scholarship

Purpose:

The Janet Coulouris Memorial Scholarship is dedicated to the memory our beloved WOW treasurer who passed away unexpectedly in December 2016. This scholarship is awarded to a college-bound senior based on a demonstrated passion for the mental and physical health and welfare of humans or animals.

Criteria:

Eligible seniors graduating Wilmington High School that intend to continue their education at a college or university. Consideration may be given to the student's community service record.

Guidelines:

Interested students should submit a scholarship application and essay on the form provided. Essay should be at least 500 words and explain the applicant's passion for human or animal health (whether mental or physical), why it is important to them, how caring and compassion in this capacity helps the greater community, and any examples of how the applicant's life has been touched/shaped by this passion.

Amount:

The Janet Coulouris Memorial Scholarship is a \$2,500 scholarship awarded each spring at the Wilmington High School scholarship night.

Deadline:

The application deadline is May 5th. The deadline is the date after which applications will no longer be accepted. We're One Wilmington uses the postmarked date to determine mailed entries.
