\$2,000 and \$1,000 Scholarships:

One to a Wilmington High School graduate and the remainder to the most deserving students regardless of high school attended.

ELIGIBILITY: Wilmington residents, graduates of an accredited high school, who have lived in the community for the past four years prior to graduation.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING WINNERS:

- A. Financial need.
- B. Academic standing, including four (4) year transcript.
- C. Student activity - List all activities, i.e., class officers, clubs, yearbook staff, etc..
- D. Athletic - Membership on athletic teams

- E. Community Service - All involvement in community, volunteer, church, service or charity group, i.e., Boy Scouts, Rainbow, hospital volunteer.
- F. Recommendations - Two letters of recommendation from any of the following:

School Administrator	Guidance Counselors
Department Heads	Teachers
Coaches	Advisors
- G. Letter of Intent - To be composed solely by the applicant indicating why the applicant feels that he/she is deserving of this award. Letter not to exceed 500 words.
- H. Personal interview may be required.
- I. Name of the College you will be attending and your estimated financial need. Also, please disclose any other financial aid that you have already received or are anticipating. Failure to include this information will result in the disqualification of your application.
