the model of selflessness and sacrifice, willingly and generously giving endless time, money, and resources to those he loved. Trooper Devlin's sense of humor was one of his best qualities and helped to carry him through whatever life threw at him. On July 26, 2018, Trooper Devlin was conducting a routine traffic stop on Route 3 in Billerica when he was struck by a motorist who had failed to move over. On September 3, 2020, he succumbed to those injuries.
