NASSAU AVENUE  
WATER STORAGE TANK  
DEMOLITION PROJECT**

Sealed Bids for the Nassau Avenue Water Storage Tank Demolition Project will be received by the Office of the Town Manager at the Wilmington Town Hall, 121 Glen Road, Wilmington, MA 01887, until 11:00 a.m. on August 11, 2022 at which place and time said Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. The bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, clearly marked to indicate the contents.

The work includes obtaining the Town's demolition permit and associated requirements, Mass-DEP notifications, demolition, removal, and disposal of the existing 125' height x 30' diameter riveted steel water storage tank, protection of adjacent telecommunications buildings and equipment, installation of new chain link fence, installation of three (3) new fence gates, plugging the existing tank inlet piping at the base of the tank, and restoring disturbed surfaces.

Each General bid shall be accompanied by a bid security in the form of a certified, treasurer's or cashier's check, bid bond or cash in the amount of five (5) percent of the value of the Bid.

Successful General bidder must furnish 100 percent Construction Performance Bond and 100 percent Construction Payment Bond.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all bids. A bid which includes, for any item, a unit cost that is abnormally low or high may be rejected as unbalanced. The right is also reserved to accept any bid deemed to be best for the interest of the Town of Wilmington.

Minimum wage rates as determined by the Department of Workforce Development under the provisions of M.G.L., Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27D, inclusive apply to this project.

Materials and supplies used or incorporated in the performance of this contract are exempt from sales and use tax.

The bidding and award of the Contract shall be in full compliance with Sections 39M inclusive of Chapter 30 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as last revised.
