Notice is hereby given that a Public Hearing will be conducted via remote participation on Wednesday, January 4, 2023, at 7:10 p.m. in compliance with the provisions of MGL Chapter 131, Section 40, and 310 CMR 10.00 on a Notice of Intent filed by Tess Paganelli, Massachusetts Bay Transit Authority (MBTA), 10 Park Plaza Suite 6720, Boston, MA 02116, owner and applicant. This filing is to remove the existing train station platform and construct a raised 200-foot train platform. This work is within Riverfront Area, Bordering Land Subject to Flooding, and the 100-foot buffer zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands as designated by the MA Wetlands Protection Act, M.G.L. Chapter 131, Sect. 40 and 310 CMR 10.00. This property is located at 364R Middlesex Avenue, Wilmington, MA 01887 and shown on Assessor's Map 89 Parcel 7A. The hearing will be conducted via Zoom.
