RECIPIENTS: \$4,000 and \$3,000 Scholarships:

To the most deserving students, regardless of high school attended.

\$2,000 and \$1,000 Scholarships:

One to a Wilmington High School graduate and the remainder to the most deserving students regardless of high school attended.

CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING WINNERS:

- A. Financial need.
- B. Academic standing, including four (4) year transcript.
- C. Student activity - List all activities, i.e., class officers, clubs, yearbook staff, etc..
- D. Athletic - Membership on athletic teams
- E. Community Service - All involvement in community, volunteer, church, service or charity group, i.e., Boy Scouts, Rainbow, hospital volunteer.

F. Recommendations - Two letters of recommendation from any of the following:

G. Letter of Intent - To be composed solely by the applicant indicating why the applicant feels that he/she is deserving of this award. Letter not to exceed 500 words.
