INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for furnishing and installing the following item: **One (1) set of Solar Powered Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB)** will be received at the Office of the Town Manager, Wilmington Town Hall, 121 Glen Road, Wilmington, MA 01887 until the time specified below at which time the bids will be opened and read remotely as described in the bid specifications package.

If the contract awarded is more than \$25,000, the winning bidder shall supply a payment bond and performance bond in the amount of 50% of the total bid within 10 days of the bid award. Payment and Performance bonds must be issued by a surety that is qualified to do business under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and satisfactory to the Town of Wilmington.

All bids for this project are subject to applicable public bidding laws of Massachusetts, including, but not limited to G.L. c.30, §39M.

Attention is directed to the minimum wage rates to be paid as determined by the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development and the weekly payroll record submittal requirements under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 through 27D inclusive.

Selection of the contractor will be based upon bidder qualifications, including evidence of past performance in similar projects, and bid price. The contract will be awarded to the bidder deemed by the awarding authority to be the lowest responsible and eligible bidder.

The bidder agrees that its bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 30 days, Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded, after the opening of the bids.

The Town reserves the right to waive any informalities, to accept or reject, in whole or in part any or all bids, or take whatever other action may be deemed to be in the best interest of the Town.
