**Ballardvale Street
over Intermittent Stream
Culvert Repair Project**

Sealed bids for furnishing the following item; **Ballardvale Street over Intermittent Stream Culvert Repair Project** will be received at the Office of the Town Manager, Wilmington, Massachusetts Town Hall, 121 Glen Road, Wilmington, MA 01887 until the time specified below at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read.

Beginning on Wednesday, August 13, 2025, any bidding documents (i.e. specifications and bid forms) may be obtained electronically free of charge in PDF format by visiting the Procurement Department website at <https://www.wilmingtonma.gov/purchasing-department>. Bidders must register through the Procurement Department website to receive electronic bids. Once registered, the bidder will receive updates or addenda to the contract documents. Hard copies of the bidding documents are not available and will only be distributed electronically. There is no pre-bid meeting for this project.

Bids will be opened in the Office of the Town Manager on Thursday, September 4, 2025 at 10 a.m. Each Bid must be accompanied by a bid security consisting of a **BID BOND, CASH, or, CERTIFIED CHECK** issued by a responsible bank or trust company in the amount of 5% of the bid price.

A performance bond in an amount equal to 100 percent of the total amount of the contract price with a surety company qualified to do business in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts will be required for the faithful performance of the contract, as well as a labor and materials bond in an amount equal to 100 percent of the total contract price.

All bids for this project are subject to applicable public bidding laws of Massachusetts, including, but not limited to G.L. c.30, §39M.

Attention is directed to the minimum wage rates to be paid as determined by the Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development and the weekly payroll record submittal requirements under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 through 27D inclusive.

Selection of the contractor will be based upon bidder qualifications, including evidence of past performance in similar projects, and bid price. The contract will be awarded to the bidder deemed by the awarding authority to be the lowest responsible and eligible bidder.

The bidder agrees that its bid shall be good and may not be withdrawn for a period of 30 days, Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded, after the opening of the bids. The Town reserves the right to waive any

informalities, to accept or reject,
in whole or in part any or all bids,
or take whatever other action
may be deemed to be in the best
interest of the Town.
