Scholarships and Eligibility

The Legacy Scholarship

The Shawsheen Alumni Association Legacy Scholarship will be given to an outstanding Shawsheen Tech High School graduate who demonstrates commitment to his/her community as well as academic achievement. **To be eligible** for this scholarship, this **recipient must also be the child of a Shawsheen Tech graduate.**

The Vocational Achievement Scholarship

The Shawsheen Alumni Association Vocational Achievement Scholarship will be given to any outstanding SVTHS graduate who demonstrate significant achievement in their vocational shops, display an excellent attitude and work ethic, and most importantly, exemplify the qualities of workmanship in a student. Recommendations from teachers and other faculty will be solicited for this award, as well as information gathered from the general scholarship application.

You may apply for both scholarships if you are eligible for both.

Completed applications must be postmarked by April 24, 2026

Selection Process

The Scholarship Committee will base its decisions upon a completed application along with evidence of commitment to academic and/or vocational performance, leadership, community service and volunteer activities.

Currently, the Association awards one-time scholarships annually. The annual scholarship amounts and number of recipients will be based on the performance of the Association's fundraising activities. The scholarships will be made payable to the recipient. All recipients that have been selected will be honored at the SVTHS Scholarship Night. Applications are also available at the School's Guidance Office.

Scholarship Review Criteria

The scholarship applications will be reviewed/rated for its eligibility/qualifications, completeness, and responses of these categories.

- All questions must be answered appropriately (None Missed)
- Clarity (Descriptive, Believable, Flow)
- Personal Opinion
