Purchases by the Town of Wilmington are exempt from any Federal, State, Municipal and/or excise tax.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Deposit equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid price shown on the Bid Form. The Bid Deposit may be made in the form of a certified check or appropriate Bid Bond issued by a surety licensed by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The Bid Deposit of the three lowest bidders shall be held until the execution of the contract awarded pursuant to this IFB, all other Bid Deposits shall be returned within ten (10) business days of the opening of the bids. In the event that the successful bidder fails to execute the contract when presented by the Town as provided herein, the bidder's Bid Deposit shall be forfeited to the extent of the difference between its bid and the next lowest bid of a responsive and responsible bidder.

The Town of Wilmington reserves the right to cancel this IFB, to waive any formality, and/or to reject any or all bids or any parts thereof deemed not to be in the best interest of the Town of Wilmington. The award of the contract to successful bidder is contingent upon an appropriation of sufficient funds.

The bidder certifies under penalties of perjury that this bid has been made and submitted in good faith and without collusion or fraud.
