Chapter 149A, The Town of Wilmington, through its school building committee (SBC), requests that qualified and experienced DCAMM Certified trade contractors submit Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) for the Wilmington Elementary School Building Project located at 320 Salem Street in Wilmington, MA. The Project consists of the new construction of a 3-story, 165,035 gsf elementary school. Interested trade contractors are sought for the following categories of work, at the estimated values indicated below.

* For an early electrical package including an underground duct bank and associated work.
